



All One Ocean Ocean Warriors Camp Counselor 2021 Job Description

Description of the organization:

All One Ocean's mission is to educate our communities about litter entering our waterways and how it affects our health and our environment. We believe the solution to degradation of our waterways starts with education, and we provide crucial education through our two primary programs: Ocean Warriors (OW), our elementary school environmental leadership program, and our Beach Cleanup program. Bay Area based All One Ocean, a Project of Earth Island Institute, was founded by Hallie Iglehart in 2010 after encountering a seagull entangled in fishing line on her daily beach walk. Iglehart untangled the bird, but knew her work wasn't finished and she developed a simple yet powerful tool – Beach Cleanup Stations, which have been used to remove over 1.1 million pieces of trash since their inception. Since 2011, All One Ocean has installed over 54 Beach Cleanup Stations in California, Baja, across the USA, Mexico and beyond. Complementing this work we focus our education primarily around Ocean Warriors, our youth based environmental leadership program. This camp and after-school program incorporates Project-Based Learning, hands-on-experience and outdoor experiential learning. Ocean Warriors and is a sustainable approach to changing behaviors at the source and creating a new generation of environmental leaders, making beneficial daily choices for our environment. Tying in our Ocean Warriors and Beach Cleanup Station programming, we organize education based beach cleanups to entire communities focused on community building, team work and gaining a deeper understanding of how pollution effects our global eco-systems.

Summary: The position of Ocean Warriors Counselor will be for at least 3-6 months, with the potential to be renewed based on performance. This position will run the day-to-day Ocean Warriors Camp Program. Duties will include: daily participation during camp hours, outreach, curriculum research and development, develop of program components, working directly with campers and parents, working directly with schools, faculty and students and presenting in front of large assemblies.

This position requires a self-motivated, outgoing and organized candidate who can excel at taking on new projects, think outside of the box and be an advocate for Environmental Leadership. The ideal candidate is energetic, outgoing and loves to work with kids. This candidate will also need to have his or her own computer, Internet availability, phone, and transportation and live in the Bay Area to perform this job.

Self-motivated and excels at taking on new tasks, able to work independently

Willingness to get dirty

Accepts direction easily

Excellent communication skills both written and verbal

Loves working with children and knows how to communicate to them

Prior camp or CIT experience is a plus.

Lifeguard and/or CPR training is ideal.
